

# Indonesia National Space Policy

- Space activities in Indonesia are based on Law of the Republic of Indonesia No. 21 of 2013 on Space Activities;
- Based on Article 7 of the Law, space activities include: space sciences; remote sensing; space technology capability; launching; and commercialization of space activities;
- In order to implement the Indonesia Space Law and to manage space activities in Indonesia a Presidential Regulation No. 45 of 2017 on Space Activities for 2016-2040 was enacted on April 2017;
- Such regulation is utilized as a Master Plan for space activities for the next 25 years;
- It contains short, medium and long term strategic road map of space activities in Indonesia;
- In order to achieve all targets stipulated in the Law and the Presidential Regulation, international cooperation is required.
