

Establishment of “Kibo Utilization Office for Asia” (KUOA)

Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA) has established a new office for Asian Kibo utilization promotion in 2010. It is named “Kibo Utilization Office for Asia”(KUOA) and directed by Mr. Shigeki Kamigaichi, Space Environment Utilization Center, Human Space Systems and Utilization Mission Directorate.
